#### 1. Introduction

When using the *Simple Job* feature, you can now sort the previously added jobs by name, instead of the creation date.

#### 2. Step by Step Configuration

- i. Access the Parameters section.
- ii. Click on Job Management to the left of the window.
- iii. At the bottom, check "Sort Pending Jobs by name".
